**Driving Directions to the
Holiday Inn**

From NJ Turnpike: Take exit 8, bear right @ 1st light onto Woodside Ave. (1/4 mile from exit ramp). The hotel will be directly in front of you.

From Princeton, Rt. 1 vicinity: Take Rt 571 East (Princeton-Hightstown Rd) into Hightstown. Turn left @ light @ end of Rt 571. Follow straight through next light, turn onto Monmouth St. Hotel is about one mile on left.

From Freehold & Points East: (via Rt 33 West) from Rt 9, Garden State Parkway, or Rt 537, pick up Rt 33 West, & follow into East Windsor/Twin Rivers. Bear right onto Monmouth St. Hotel is one mile on left.

From North Brunswick: (via Rt 130) Rt 130 South to Hightstown Circle turn left @ sign for Hightstown & shore points. Follow about one mile, then turn left onto Monmouth St (Rt 633). Hotel is one mile on left.

From Bordentown Area: (Rt 130 N) Take Rt 130 N to Rt 33 East into Hightstown. Pass through two lights. After 2nd light, make first right onto Monmouth St. Hotel is about one mile on left.
